
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

Commentary

The Mobius Investment Trust (MMIT) continued with positive Net Asset Value (NAV) performance in February with the NAV increasing by 2.3%. The share price, which was impacted by wider market movements, declined by 4.6%, bringing the discount to 7.7% at the end of the month.

February saw a return of volatility to global markets amidst concerns over stronger than expected growth and a higher inflation outlook, leading to a rise in interest rates. U.S. 10-year Treasury yields reached a high of 1.6% at the end of February (up from under 1% at the end of 2020), negatively impacting EM equities. Despite these developments, we believe that emerging markets are set for a strong year with earnings recovering steadily, valuations remaining low, and many emerging markets currencies undervalued. Furthermore, MMIT's portfolio is geared to profit from behavioural shifts in the wake of the pandemic. In February, we strengthened our exposure to the technology sector with one new holding which is yet to reach target weight.

The largest contributors in February were Taiwanese semiconductor company eMemory (+1.4%), leading Indian steel tubes and pipes manufacturer, APL Apollo (+1.1%) and Indian software and digital services company, Persistent Systems (0.7%).

The largest detractors were Chinese Health care company AK Medical (-0.4%), Turkish apparel company Mavi (-0.3%) and Turkish software company Logo Yazilim (-0.3%).
