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Performance since launch to 31 July 2021*





Commentary

July saw emerging markets negatively impacted by a number of events. Foremostly, China's crackdown on the private education sector unsettled investor confidence and sent the Chinese and Hong Kong markets tumbling. This affected other Asian stock markets and led to a negative monthly return of the Mobius Investment Trust for the first time this year. This was a reflection of the wider sentiment and not the fundamentals of MMIT's portfolio companies. MCP continues to invest carefully and conservatively in China, minimising exposure to any regulatory risk.

The spread of the Delta Variant, strong U.S. corporate earnings and the Fed's monetary policy meeting also impacted investors and sentiment towards emerging markets. The NAV and Share Price of MMIT declined by -4.3% and -1.0% respectively. Year-to-date, MMIT generated a return of 23.9% (NAV). Driven by investor interest, MMIT entered premium territory at the beginning of the month, closing at +2.0% on 30 July 2021.

During July, the strongest performers in the portfolio were Indian Software company Persistent Systems (+0.7%), followed by Indian steel pipes producer APL Apollo (+0.6%) and Taiwanese fabless semiconductor company Parade Technologies (+0.3%). The detractors in July were Chinese orthopaedic implants producer A.K. Medical (-1.1%), Chinese health care services provider EC Healthcare (-0.7%) and Brazilian e-commerce company Americanas S.A (-0.6%).
